This distribution is for general community preparedness. Calvert County Health Department routinely distributes KI tablets to those living or working within the 10 mile emergency planning zone (EPZ) of Calvert County surrounding the Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant.

Residents and businesses within the EPZ are encouraged to pick up KI to replace expired supply. Individuals may bring expired KI tablets for collection and disposal.

One representative (age 18 or older) may pick up for their household or business.

Areas south of Prince Frederick are likely within the EPZ. Eligible zip codes: 20629, 20688, 20657, 20615, 20685, 20676, 20610, and parts of 20678.

In the unlikely event of a radiological incident, KI may be part of emergency response secondary to evacuation and sheltering. It should only be taken when advised by officials and protects the thyroid from damage.
